5.0 Regular Agenda

Accept the 2016-17 Midyear Financial Report. Stanislaus Regional 911 (SR911) Executive Director Scotty Douglass discussed the fiscal performance of the Agency through the four months ended October 31, 2016. that the budget surplus for 2016-17 would be significantly less than the surplus This is primarily due to the zero-based budgeting exercise completed during the 2016-17 budget preparation. Most of the budget surplus is due to staffing shortages. As of November 2016, the Agency is almost completed staffed. On December 20, 2016, the County Board of Supervisors approved a temporary "double-fill" of 4.0 dispatch positions through the end of the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year.

Stan Risen expressed his gratitude to the Agency, stating that the report showed transparency and accountability.

Motion to approve the 2016-17 Midyear Financial Report O'Brien seconded by Slamon. Approved. 7-0 unan.

5.2 Accept the Status Report Regarding Dispatcher Staffing. SR911 Operations Manager Wendy Silva commented that all dispatcher positions are full and only one call-taker position is open. Due to the continuous recruitment that was established, the agency has 18 applicants that are ready to enter the background investigations process.

Bill O'Brien expressed his pleasure will the progress. Stan Risen questioned the last time the Agency was fully staffed. Silva stated that with one exception within the last year, it had been several years.

Motion to approve the recommendation made by O'Brien seconded by Slamon. Approved. 7-0 unan.

 - 6.1 Oral update from SR911 Executive Director. Scotty Douglass discussed the challenges with the CAD to CAD update and the CAD 2.1 upgrade. Douglass expects them both to be completed in the first quarter of 2017.

Jim Holgersson thanked Commissioner O'Brien for his hard work on the Commission. Commissioner O'Brien stated that it was the work of the staff and especially dispatchers and call-takers that was most important.
