Stanislaus Regional 9-1-1 (SR911) Administrative Service Manager John Bettencourt (Bettencourt) shared the financial audit is the examination of the financial data as presented by the Consolidated Emergency Dispatch Agency Financial Statements. The purpose of the audit is to form an opinion on whether the information presented in the Financial Statement, taken as a whole, reflects the financial position of the Consolidated Emergency Dispatch Agency as of June 30, 20221.
