5.2 Approve the Request for Stanislaus Regional 9-1-1 to Enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Riverbank to Provide a Location for Communications Equipment for the Purpose of Improving Public Safety Communications Systems

Office of Emergency Services (OES) Interim Deputy Director of SR911 Erik Klevmyr (Klevmyr) shared that the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Riverbank is to provide a location for communications equipment for the purpose of improving public safety communications systems. Funding for this project is available through the Stanislaus County Fire Warden's Office AB109 (2019) grant. The City of Riverbank has agreed to allow the space for this site, provided the City is able to place radio equipment of their own on the tower, once constructed. SR911 will pay for the construction of the tower and the electrical service to the tower and associated equipment. Commissioner Hayes asked Klevmyr to provide an update on the total project, a reminder on what the intent was and how it is progressing in a future meeting. Commissioner Hayes also asked the update to include what is happening with the platforms for transmissions.
