- 4.1 Update on the Stanislaus Regional 9-1-1 Central Square Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) System Implementation Stanislaus Regional 9-1-1 (SR911)

Executive Director Kasey Young (Young) gave an update on the Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system implementation. Young shared that on August 8, Central Square released a newer version of the CAD software, which the CAD Team has been actively evaluating. The team recommends moving forward with this updated version, as it includes several enhancements beneficial to both dispatchers and field responders. Scheduling is currently under review to ensure the entire team is available for implementation. Once finalized, a new go-live date will be communicated to the commission.

Commissioner Grewal noted that at recent CEDAC meetings, the September 22 go-live date was presented with strong confidence. He expressed concern that the August 8 release of the updated CAD version was not shared at the last meeting and stressed the importance of keeping the commission informed so they remain aware of any potential changes to the project timeline.
